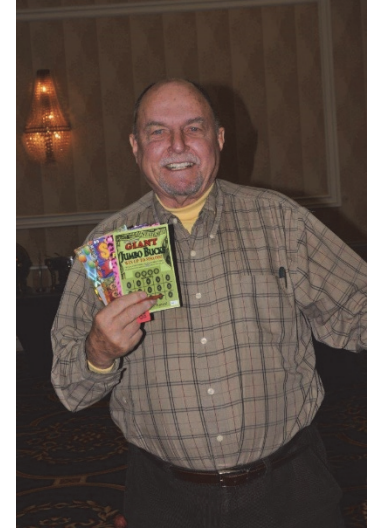
**January 29<sup>th</sup> Meeting**
